SIDEWALK DINING ORDINANCE INFORMATION



The following document summarizes Waxhaw's Sidewalk Dining Ordinance. This does not replace compliance with the ordinance and you are recommended to read the ordinance in its entirety.

Sidewalk Dining is only applicable to businesses located along North Main Street between North Providence Street and Hicks Street, and South Main Street between South Church Street and McKibben Street. Regulations include sidewalk dining that occurs within the public right-of-way.

Paper and online applications are accepted.




SIDEWALK DINING ORDINANCE ACCESSIBILITY

ADA compliance helps visitors and your customers navigate downtown safely and comfortably. Non-compliance may result in denial or suspension of a sidewalk dining permit.



Tables, chairs, and other furnishings must be placed to leave at least five feet of unobstructed space for the passage of pedestrians. Fire lanes and exits must remain clear at all times.

Restaurants serving alcohol within sidewalk dining area must visibly and vertically section off the area using stanchions or planters. Height must be between 3' and 4'2" and detectable by the visually impaired. Stanchions must not be a tripping hazard and can measure no more than 1" above sidewalk surface.







NOTE: If two people walking side by side have to go single file or if a wheelchair cannot pass through without maneuvering, your sidewalk is not accessible.


SIDEWALK DINING ORDINANCE **OPERATION**



The sidewalk dining must be associated with the operating restaurant and may not be open or operated at any time when the restaurant is not open for business.

The seating capacity of the sidewalk dining may not be more than 50% of the indoor seating capacity of the associated restaurant.






Furnishings may not extend beyond the sidewalk frontage of the associated restaurant.

Alcoholic Beverages

- Sidewalk dining area must be included as part of the premises for which an ABC permit is issued.
- Signs shall be posted and visible at all exit points from the sidewalk dining that alcohol cannot be removed from premises.
- No outdoor bar is allowed within the sidewalk dining and outdoor preparation of alcoholic beverages is not permitted, except unfortified wine may be decanted or beer poured at a table.

IN COMPLIANCE



Tables and Chairs

- Easily moveable
- Approved by Zoning Administrator



Stanchions/Barricades

- Black Metal (aluminum, steel, wrought iron, etc.).
- Painted or stained wood.
- Commercial grade planters.
- Between 3' and 4'2" in height.



Planters

- No more than 3' in height.
- Plants must be shorter than 6' in height.
- Plants must be alive and in healthy condition.



Umbrellas

- Outdoor fabric with commercial grand stand.
- No logos or other signage.



Cleanliness

- Sidewalk and dining area is free of trash and debris.
- Spills and stains removed on a weekly basis.
- Furnishings and barricades cleaned and maintained at all times.

SIDEWALK DINING ORDINANCE APPEARANCE EXAMPLES

Tables and Chairs

Easily moveable
High-quality, outdoor materials
Color is okay, but must be approved by zoning administrator
Maintain consistent look and feel of downtown







Stanchions/Barricades/Planters

Only required by those serving alcohol on sidewalk High-quality, outdoor materials Maintains consistent look and feel of downtown Real plants must be alive and healthy







SIDEWALK DINING ORDINANCE PERMIT APPLICATION CHECKLIST
